Golcar Ladies Lifeboat Guild

The first meeting of the Golcar Ladies Lifeboat Guild was held at Golcar Town Hall on Wednesday 9th March 1927. The Chairman of Colne Valley Urban District Council, Councillor J A Bradley JP presided, and there were present 34 ladies who were interested in forming a group. An address was given by Miss Irwin, Assistant District Organising Secretary from the RNLI, and a resolution was passed as follows:

"That this meeting recognises the important services of the Royal National Lifeboat Institution, in its national work of lifesaving and desires to record its hearty appreciation of the gallantry of the Coxswains and Crews of the Institution, and resolves to appoint a Golcar and District Lifeboat Guild with all members attending and having the power to attend to their number".

The first Chairlady was Mrs Bradford, The Sycamores, Golcar. Vice President was Mrs Percy Whitwam, Clifton House, Golcar.

A Flag Day was arranged and the village was divided into areas, for different members to cover. This raised £23.5.9d. As at the end of the first year the balance in hand was £28.2.6d; £25 would be sent to Headquarters and 2/6d given to the Caretaker of the Town Hall, for his help during the year, also 2/6d given to the Secretary to cover postages.

During the first few years this Flag Day was the main source of fund raising, moving on to Whist Drives and Bridge evenings, which were held in the Conservative Club. Even during the war years the group carried on.

Things have moved on, of course, over the years but the Lifeboat Group now in Golcar comprises of 16 ladies. During the coming year we are hoping to hold a few special events to commemorate this special occasion of 90 years. On 18th May 2017 we are having the Mikron Theatre Company at the Bolster Moor Farm Shop; the play being 'In at the Deep End' which is the story of the Lifeboat, its Lifeboat Men and fundraisers- all volunteers!!! Please come along to support this for our 90th Birthday. Tickets are £13 and £11 (concessions) and can be purchased from the Bolster Moor Farm Shop or by ringing 01484 653195. Half of the entry money will go to the RNLI. We follow this on 10th June with a concert at St Johnís Church, Golcar, with Simeon Wood, a local boy who is an exceptional Multi-instrumentalist. Descriptions include, 'An exhilarating show of musical

brilliance', 'Very funny and hugely entertaining, a great night out'. Tickets are £10 and can be purchased from Just Groovy, Town End, Golcar and Colne Valley Motor Parts, Carr Lane, Slaithwaite or by ringing 01484 653195 or 01484 843261.

A Golcar Girlguiding volunteer has been recognised in The Queen's New Year Honours for her work supporting girls and young women over the last 49 years.

Golcar Girlguiding volunteer Margaret Shaw, leader with the 19th Huddersfield (Golcar Church) Brownies and Rainbows was awarded the British Empire Medal by Her Majesty the Queen in honour of her inspirational efforts for her work supporting girls and young women over the last 49 years.

Margaret (65) first became involved in guiding as a leader when she joined 6th Jersey (St. Lawrence) Brownie Unit in 1967. Margaret's highlights during her time with Girlguiding include herself as a Guide in the 20thJersey (St. Mary's) company. She learnt so much & had such fun & particularly loved camping. One of her highlight's was to be selected to join a UK party to an international camp in Sweden. Her Guiding Promise has always meant so much to her that, in 2012, she did a sponsored climb of Mount Baden Powell in California to celebrate 50 years of her commitment to it. However. it was a 2015 trip, with a Durham Senior Section unit. to Sangam World Guiding Centre in India that really showed her the capabilities & enormous enthusiasm of young women who had been Rainbows, Brownies & Guides. A very important part of Margaret's time in guiding has been to share its joys & benefits with others & this is this is why she has also spent over 35 years as a Girlguiding Trainer & Mentor throughout northern England.

Alan Kaye 1944 to 2016

Sadly, on the 29th of May 2016 Golcar lost a valued member of the community and we lost a treasured member of our family.

Alan lived in Golcar for all but five of the seventy-one years of his life, primarily due to his love of the place and its people. Growing up on Handle Street, he attended Knowl Bank School from 1949 to 1956. He then moved on to be part of the first intake at the newly built Colne Valley High School, which he attended until 1961. He thoroughly enjoyed his time at school, and was particularly interested in

sports being crowned cross-country champion in his final year. Alan's love for sport continued throughout his life. He enjoyed playing cricket for Leymoor CC, going on to help the club from his position on the committee, whilst undertaking the role of vice-chair at Huddersfield Central Cricket League. Just before his passing Alan was presented his life-membership of the cricket league, and he took great pride in the recognition of his commitment to the local game.

Alan married the love of his life Yvonne in 1965 and they were blessed with two children, Richard and Alison. Just like Alan, his children and grandchildren were raised in Golcar, which allowed him to spend much of his later life enjoying time with his family, which he cherished so dearly.

Despite Alan's commitment to his family, he was also tireless in his commitment to the community of Golcar. Alan served on the board of Governors at Golcar J,I and N for several years, and undertook the position of Chair of Governors for 6 years. Be it helping with fundraising, or reading to reception class. he loved his time at the school. Additionally, Alan was on the committee in charge of organising the annual Golcar Lily Day, showing once again his pride for his home village of Golcar

Alan was truly a unique man. There were no lengths he would not go to support anyone he could, and he stopped at nothing to ensure everything he was involved in was the best it could be. We hope that the time he gave so freely to our community will have a positive and lasting impact, and for that we will be forever proud.


