

Guided ginnel walk

Maps are available on Lily Day from the Welcome stand in Jubilee Square, the library and the Golcar Lily Day stall in the car park at Town End.

Time: 1.00

Meet: St John's Church gates, Church Street

Distance: approximately 3 kilometres.

A shorter walk is also possible.

Duration: approximately 1 hour 30 minutes

There are 3 fairly steep climbs but they are only short. Wear suitable footwear, and if required bring a stick or walking pole. Maps are available on Lily Day from the library and the Golcar Lily Day stall in the car park at Town End.

Beyond Golcar's ginnels, this walk takes past a well-hidden but spectacular weaver's cottage and then along the canal towpath. Mid May is an ideal time to walk along the towpath as the trees look beautiful with their lush foliage. You might even see the electric-blue flash of a kingfisher as it darts past you.

Minibuses

As well as all the entertainment in Golcar, there's also lots to do at the venues. Two free minibuses will be operating on Lily Day to drop you off at a venue and then either take you to another venue or bring you back to Golcar. Hop aboard to visit Bolster Moor, Sycamore Avenue, Golcar Baptist, Scapegoat Hill, Parkwood and Providence.

Park and ride is available from the Pennine Manor, Scapegoat Hill.

Golcar United Football Team

Golcar United was established in 1904 and played in the Huddersfield District League. During the 1930's the team regularly played in front of in excess of 1000 people and even featured on cigarette coupons. The teams moved to the current base at Longfield in 1955 where we have been based ever since. In 1993 Golcar United joined the West Riding County Amateur League and now run four adult sides(one in the WRCAL and one in the Huddersfield District and one veterans team). This season we also re-joined the RDC Junior League, fielding teams at under 7, under 9, under 10 and under 11. We aim to be a community standard club by the start of the 2016 - 2017 season.

The first team plays in the premier league of the West Riding County Amateur League and finished runner up last year. Our second team plays in Division 2 of the WRCAL and are currently on course for promotion. The third team recently moved into the Huddersfield District League and we aim to use this team along with the Under 21 team to help young players gain experience of open age foot ball.

The club has recently gained funding to help to develop the ground at Longfield to improve facilities for the community. We have a grant from LV to improve the showers. Zeneca has provided funding and manpower to improve the access. The Winkle Club

provided funding towards the dug outs and the Football Foundation has helped to fund a tea bar, new goals, ground equipment and improvements to the changing facilities. We also have numerous local sponsors who are invaluable to the club. Without their outstanding and continued support we would struggle.

As a club we have realised the importance of providing junior football for Golcar. We have not had teams entered in the Junior Section since the late 1990's. Starting with eight children and a couple of footballs in February 2014 on Golcar Cricket Field we now have five teams entered into the league. We have self-funded to ensure that all coaches gain the relevant qualifications. We currently have over one hundred children signed on and playing every weekend at our base at Golcar JNI School on Manor Road. As a club we want to focus on expanding the junior section and hope to offer football across all age groups.

Golcar United aims to offer affordable football to Golcar and the surrounding community. If anyone would like to help with sponsorship we would be extremely grateful. Bolster Moor Nursery

As from September, Bolster Moor will have a brand new nursery! The new facility will still be at the former Chapel where the existing play group currently operates, but will be open 51weeks of the year, and offer a much wider range of child care options.

The current playgroup has a long standing history within the community, but when the Baptist Association put the Chapel up for sale, it was no longer financially viable for it to continue in its present form, being a registered charity, as a huge amount or remedial work was required on the building. Fortunately, the co owners of the Farm Shop came to the rescue and bought the building, and also the current chairperson of the playgroup has invested in the venture and will run the new nursery, which will be fully refurbished offering a bright, modern and stimulating environment. which will still be at the heart of the Community.

Our group represents the 8th company of the 33rd Foot, from their return in 1812 to the final peace in 1816. We portray a standard line company, typical of the redcoats of the time and the backbone of the British Army. Emphasis is placed on the life of the ordinary infantry private during times of peace & war.

As a company we attend events all over the country ranging from small appearances to large battles with hundreds involved. Larger events often occur on the continent with many nationalities taking part. There are also many "living history" events where we show how soldiers lived from day to day. Barracks scenes and camps are often set up showing many of the other activities soldiers took part in when not fighting. During the winter months we have regular meetings and drill practices where members learn the period drill and manoeuvres.



Stockport Morris Dancers

"In October 1885 there were several morris dancers at Northenden, then Cheshire now south Manchester.

They had light coloured trousers tied with ribbons at the knees, white shirt sleeves, straw hats trimmed with ribbons and artificial flowers. The music was made by triangle, fifes and drums.

On the 21st September 1889, being Stockport Wakes (industrial holidays) a band of morris dancers perambulated the streets in the evening dressed in white stockings, knee breeches, white shirts trimmed with ribbons and small caps. They were preceded by a good band of music playing dance tunes, in front which was a lusty

man plying a big whip. In the rear was "old sooty face" with a well patronised collecting box. The following Monday they paraded Edgeley preceded by a lorry decorated with arches and carrying a number of little girls prettily dressed.

At the Wakes in 1890 a troop of morris dancers were habited in black jockey caps, white shirts, black knee breeches, blue sashes, white stockings and black shoes. Instead of handkerchiefs they had thick white cords tied to the wrist and knotted at the end. "

These reports were from original archive material

When the side reformed in 1984 the main membership comprised Dads whose offspring were enjoying themselves too much in the guise of "The Fosbrooks".
