Dog Wardens

We will be attending the Golcar Lily Day as part of our new team. This team comprises of Dog Wardens, Enforcement Officers and Rangers. We hope that by bringing these teams together we will be better able to serve the people of Kirklees.

On the day we will be offering free Microchipping to all, courtesy of the Dogs Trust. The Enforcement Officers will be out and about giving advice to people about littering; the Rangers will support both teams as well as engaging with the community to build further links. 

The Life of a Golcar Lily

I was born at 18 Garden terrace, James Street, Golcar in 1949 and grew up in the 50's. I have lived in Golcar all my life so, without doubt, I qualify as a true Golcar Lily.

I lived in a three bedroom terrace house with mum. dad. two brothers and grandad. The only heating was from coal fires. It was my job to sit on the door step when the coal man delivered the coal to count the empty bags to make sure he didn't "diddle us"! The chimney sweep came once a year. What a task to remove and cover furniture and carpets. then run outside to see the brush come out of the chimney top. I ran errands for neighbours and was rewarded with a "penny for going". I remember that when someone died on our street the neighbours would have a collection towards a wreath and to show respect everyone would close their upstairs curtains. Taking pride in the outside of your house was very important,

swilling the yard and donkey stoning the steps and window sills were weekly jobs!

I attended Golcar C of E School on Church Street (which has now been converted into apartments) opposite the old Police Station. At that time the headmaster was Mr Hardwick. The first class was the "baby class" which was in the main hall. At 11,45am the hall was transformed into the main dining room. There were three classes in the infants and four in the juniors. The classes were large and J1 had a fireplace where a fire roared in winter. This room was also the Parish Room. I can well remember chalk, board rubbers and bunches of keys being thrown by the teachers! The best day of the year was the annual trip to St. Annes on Hanson Coaches!

Church and Sunday School were a big part of our lives, attending twice a day. There was the whitsuntide walk around Golcar with Scape Band, then tea in the Parish Room followed by games on the vicarage lawn. The Sunday School Anniversary was a big day, with everyone in new clothes and the ladies wearing their new hats! Attending the church School, Ascension Day and Ash Wednesday were holidays from school but only after we had attended Church first at 9am.

Playing out was an important part of my childhood. We could plav in the street then as there was very little traffic. We played jacks, tin can squat, hide and seek, fairies and witches, French cricket, dolls and prams and we were dand members (if you had the badge!) It seemed to snow more then and we would sledge down the "death track" towards Nancy Bridge. On Saturday afternoon I remember going to the Picture House in Leymoor Road. There was always a feature film followed by Black Arrow, a serial, which always stopped at the most exciting part, to be concluded next week.

The Life of a Golcar Lily

Christmas was an exciting time. There was a huge christmas tree in Jubilee Square with a large wooden nativity scene. On Christmas Eve Scape Band marched through the streets of Golcar playing carols all night then they came round with collecting boxes on Christmas morning. Our Christmas tree at home was never erected until Christmas eve!

Golcar had two thriving shopping centres. On

James Street (including Brook Lane) there were approximately 20 shops and Town End had a similar number. The only 'takeaways' were five fish and chip shops. Many changes have taken place over the last 60 years such as development of Banks Estate, Woodroyd, Wyvern Road and Sycamore Avenue which were all once fields and farmland. The original Baptist Chapel no longer exists. Providence

Sunday School is now Knowle Court Residential Home and Golcar Station disappeared in the 60's.

Although I have seen many changes, some good, some not so good, I still live in Golcar (Bolster Moor). I am proud to be called a Golcar Lily and on Golcar Lily Day - Golcar Lives!

Who are we?

We are a new local walking organisation and we're very pleased that we will be launching our Group at the Golcar Lily Day.

Some of you may remember that we were there at last year's Golcar Lily Day, collecting signatures on our petition so that we could affiliate to the national 'Walkers are Welcome' organisation. Well – we were successful and we are now an affiliated 'Walkers are Welcome' Group!

What are we planning to do?

Our aim is to promote and support walking in the Golcar and Slaithwaite area. We will be doing this by:

- Telling people locally about 'Walkers are Welcome'.

- Developing a website to provide lots of information about local walks and local services that walkers will want to use, such as pubs, cafes and shops.

Golcar and Slaithwaite are two traditional stone built weaving villages located in the distinct area known as the Colne Valley.

Golcar is located on a steep hillside described by Sir John Betjeman as 'Provence of the North' because of its 2/3/4 storey weaver's cottages and narrow ginnels. The village is also the location of Colne Valley Museum, a unique voluntary Museum (more than 40 yrs. old) illustrating the domestic life of a woollen weaver in the 1850's, housed in four listed weaver's cottages.

Slaithwaite in the valley bottom, has large stone mill buildings alongside Huddersfield Narrow Canal and railway line. Slaithwaite is the home of Totally Locally, local businesses which promote local produce and the whole area has a wealth of local hostelries and food outlets which cater for resident and visitors.

Both villages are surrounded by small former weaving hamlets linked by numerous public footpath routes, some formerly packhorse trails and later routes to the mills, schools, canal and railway, running up, down, around and along the valley side and bottom.

The area has a spectacular urban and rural landscape and a rich industrial heritage. Working collaboratively with the local Council, Golcar & Slathwaite WAW aims to promote the area as a visitor destination, whilst at the same time working to improve and maintain the wealth of accessible paths and byways for the benefit of both visitors and residents.


