### **Golcar Textiles**

Cloth has been woven from wool in the Colne Valley since the 1300s. Initially, farm dwellers made only the cloth they needed for their own use. Farming around here was tough and yielded only enough to feed the family - it couldn't provide a surplus that could be sold. But cloth could and from around 1500 the area's cloth trade began to develop — but still only as an adjunct to farming.

As cloth-making expanded and became profitable. the need grew for moresuitable premises and weavers' cottages were the solution. The typical cottage had 3 storeys, providing a loom chamber on the top floor and family living space below. A classic example is the Spring Rock row of cottages in Golcar, which

now houses the Colne Valley Museum.

The weavers' cottages around Golcar were built between 1770 and 1850. The characteristic rows of south-facing, mullioned windows provided plenty of light for working and, as the cottages were often built into the hillside, there was direct access to both the loom chamber and the living space.

Cottage textiles declined in the late 1800s as the mechanical inventions introduced into Lancashire's cotton manufacturing soon became established in cloth-making in the Colne Valley, Mills were built throughout the valley, including in Golcar.

The village's 3 clothmaking mills — Victoria Mill, Albion Mill and Heath House Mill — were built

around 1860 and were first used by firms created by Joseph Taylor, a Golcar weaver. John Pearson, another Golcar weaver, who had built the Spring Rock cottages, bought a share of one of the original firms at Victoria Mill and later formed Pearson Brothers. This firm prospered and in the early 1900s the mill had 9,000 spindles and 82 looms. The firm traded at Victoria Mill until 1972. At Heath House Mill, T W Thorpe Ltd traded for 99 years, closing down in 1996. When the firm started, it made nothing

but cap cloths — men bought a lot of caps in those days. Through the years it produced various products, including millions of scarves.

Golcar also had recycling mills that were processors of rags and textile waste. The most prominent were Town End Mill on Leymoor Road, Manor Mill on Manor Road, and Acre Mill on Knowl Road. These mills were operated by, respectively, Fred Singleton Ltd, F Drake & Son, and Albert Wade Ltd. The first 2 mills are now demolished and Acre Mill is The Weavers bar and restaurant.

Rag recycling began with tatters (rag and bone men) collecting old clothes from houses. They delivered them to rag merchants, who sorted them and supplied them to the processors, who ground






Polypropylene Pellets

them down and sold the resulting material (shoddy) to local mills where it would be used to make cloth.

In 1972, F Drake (Fibres) Ltd took over Victoria Mill to make polypropylene fibre for carpet manufacturers. Under managing director Jim Haigh, the firm expanded its production and twice won a Queen's Award for exports. The company is now called Drake Extrusion Ltd and as well as producing fibres for carpets, it makes fibres for other uses, including applications in the food and construction industries.

The raw material for the extrusion process is polypropylene pellets,



a by-product of the oil industry. The pellets, which are delivered by tankers and stored in silos, are heated until molten and the liquid is then forced through plates containing small holes to create the fibres.

Today, Albion Mill has been converted into flats, Heath House Mill houses small businesses in units, and production lines run at Victoria Mill for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.




