

Golcar Lily Day Meeting – 14/3/22

Reports – Treasury – currently £8,281.97 in the account. Increase from the last meeting due to the table top sale day. £60 was made from the stalls (not including what has gone straight into the bank account) £73.70 from the refreshments and £25 from the raffle.

20 stalls on GLD have been confirmed with 2 possible extras waiting on money to be paid.

There are a couple of stalls still available at the Scout centre for activities.

Fundraising has been a little lower than previous years and normally by this point in the year we have approximately £10-11,000 in order to pay for the musicians and have a float going into next year's plans.

The next big payment will be £600 (approx.) for the stalls and then the musicians and entertainment on the day itself. Insurance and licenses have been paid for as well as the outside tables and chairs.

Fundraising idea for the day from Soo – diaries for people to pick a day. £1 per date and can be organised on the day. 1st prize £40, 2nd £15 and 3rd £10, this then leaves £300 to come back into the account from the day. Louise to organise diaries and get someone to write down winning dates beforehand.

Road Closure –The company setting up the barriers normally have people on hand to man the closure anyway just in case access is needed.

Publicity – We need someone to deal with press and radio and potentially to look into Huddersfield Hub as well.

Decorations – 100 small flags, so that people participating in the parade can have something to wave, have been bought by Sue Starr. Bunting to be put up by the Winkles and left up for the Jubilee weekend. Sara Evans is organising the knitting and crochet bomb, will need to check up with the collection of this.

Entertainment - Programme has been finalised and is ready for printing. Maps are going to be the original ones printed and go up on Town End. Confirmed by Sue Starr for a flypast by Lancaster bomber. We have 10 bands all together. Jubilee trail sheets to be finished off by Louise and printed by HAD IT, just need to check with the shops on Town End to have pictures in the windows.

Stalls – 2 allocated for Lily Day, 20 definite and 2 maybe. Scouts providing BBQ tables.

Procession – SWEAT can help with the procession. Soo to ask SWEAT if they can provide a risk assessment for it, and maybe a car with flashing lights.

Environment – Scouts to be carrying out an Environment Day on the 9th April.

Around Golcar - Jubilee lunch on the 5th June at the Scout/Community centre.
Drop by Afternoon Tea on Friday 3rd June.

Queries – Winkles having a license to provide the temporary bar on GLD – need to check with Sue.

Golcar Lily Advertisement – Rob mentioned that when putting GLD into google the first site that comes up – Community Directory Kirklees – has the wrong time and date for the event – 1-5 on 7th May. Mark Evans could you please use your contacts to see if this can be changed?

Possible donations for fundraising – Round Table -through Rob, could write a letter for Rob to take it through to the next meeting.
